In the interwar period cooperatives formed for the purpose of building residential houses. One of these was the "Butas A cooperative, organized by the Supreme Tribunal officials Liudas Ciplijauskas and Martynas Kavolis. There were nine apartments according to a standard plan in a five-storey rectangular building, only on the first floor near the driveway into the yard there were two small apartments squeezed in for service workers. The large five-room apartments were planned out rationally and comfortably, with separate public, private, and service zones. Year:
