FORMER RESIDENTIAL HOUSE OF THE ECONOMIST JUOZAS DAUGIRDAS



Vytauto pr. 30, Kaunas



The house of Juozas Daugirdas, director of the "Drobė" corporation, was one of the most modern buildings in Lithuania and held to be a jewel of Vytauto Blvd at the start of the 1930s. Its first floor was dedicated for shops; the second, third, and fourth had two identical five-room apartments, with living quarters in the mezzanine as well. The portal is ornamented with a rim of Dubeneckis's beloved tulips. In 1934-1935 the French Consul Paul Py stayed in this house. Year: 1930-1931. Style: Modernism. Architect Vladimiras Dubeneckis.
