There were the houses of the state saving bank built in 1938-1940 under the project of an engineer and architect A. Funkas. Nowadays Kaunas municipality functions in the building. The building is laconic, not elaborate: vertical windows stripes prevail it. The main plan of the house volume is half closed. The central facade is six-storied, the sides are five-storied. Vertical edges of the building make its constructive and strict silhouette lighter.
