Gallery visitors can look over ancient world art exposition with collections of Ancient Egypt culture sculptures, Antique pottery, Roman glass wares and coins. There are works by XVI-XX century artists which portrayed European art. Likewise, XVII-XX century foreign applied art exhibition.

There is a museum for blind people which is located in the gallery's vault. The museum gives an opportunity for disable people to get acquainted with original modern art pieces by tactile method. Equally, there is a availability to arrange various cultural events, like concerts, presentations of books, lectures, seminars, scientific conferences, festivals of movies, various excursions. Also, there are educational programs for children, teenagers and disable people with special preparations.
